DEIS Policy & DEIS Plan 2022 - 2025

1. Introduction

Derryoober National School received **DEIS status in 2022** as part of the **Delivering Equality of Opportunity in Schools (DEIS)** initiative by the **Department of Education**. The aim of the **DEIS Action Plan** is to ensure that the educational needs of children from disadvantaged communities are met. This plan aims to **increase students' academic attainment, participation, and holistic development** while fostering strong community and parental involvement.

3. Our DEIS Philosophy

Derryoober National School exists for its pupils. The educational progress and welfare of each child is the overriding priority in decisions made by the teachers and the Board of Management. 4. SMART Targets & Key Actions

Literacy

Target: Improve comprehension skills by 10% in standardised testing by 2025.

- Implement Literacy Lift-Off and guided reading programmes.
- Encourage daily reading activities and book reviews.
- Use comprehension strategies such as predicting, questioning, summarising.
- Organise author visits and literacy week activities.

Numeracy

Target: Improve mathematical problem-solving skills by 15% by 2025.

- Implement Maths for Fun initiatives.
- Use real-life problem-solving scenarios in lessons.
- Encourage maths games and competitions.
- Administer Drumcondra Tests in Maths annually in May to monitor progress.

Attendance

Target: Maintain 95% attendance rate and reduce chronic absenteeism.

- Reward full attendance with certificates.
- Engage with parents on importance of attendance.
- Monitor and follow up on **absenteeism trends**.

Retention & Progression

Target: Ensure 100% progression to secondary school.

- Implement transition programmes for 6th class students.
- Conduct visits to secondary schools.
- Support students with career guidance and secondary school applications.

Parental & Community Engagement

Target: Increase parental involvement in school activities by 20%.

- Organise parent workshops and coffee mornings.
- Use Aladdin Connect for parent communication.
- Encourage parents to participate in school projects.

5. Monitoring & Evaluation

- Standardised test scores, attendance data, and parental engagement will be reviewed annually.
- Feedback surveys from students, parents, and teachers will inform improvements.
- Regular reports to the Board of Management will track progress.
